Coro San Marco

Coro San Marco began in 1995 as an Italian choir but has since grown to welcome members from many different backgrounds, and its repertoire has grown at the same time. The choir has performed on its own and with other choirs on many stages around Toronto and beyond including as part of the 350-voice choir with the Toronto Symphony Orchestra to close out Toronto's Olympic bid of 2001.
